**Open House Scheduled for Upcoming Greenway Trail Closure Due to Flood Control Project**

**Sioux Falls, South Dakota:** The City of Sioux Falls has scheduled an open house on Wednesday, March 25, 2009, from 5 to 6:30 p.m. at the Oyate Community Center (2421 West 15th Street—next to Garfield Elementary School) to inform and gain input from the public in regard to the upcoming Greenway Trail closure from 41st Street to the Great Plains Zoo.

The trail closure will occur late this spring as a part of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' project to raise the flood levee to provide better flood control protection for the city. The project will close the trail in this area through 2010.

Citizens are invited to attend this open house to find out more about the project and discuss options for alternative sidewalk and on-street bicycle routes.
